農工大農学部は、研究・教育に邁進中！

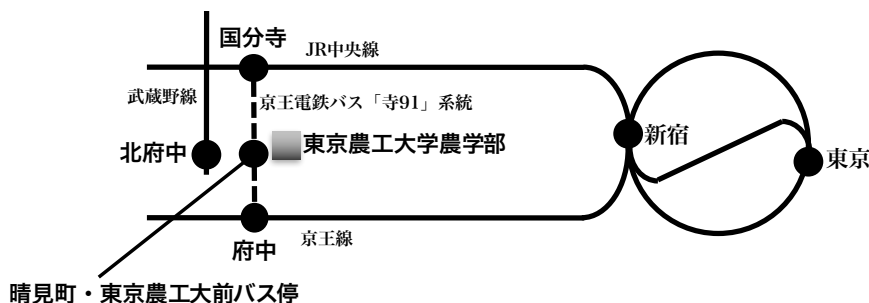

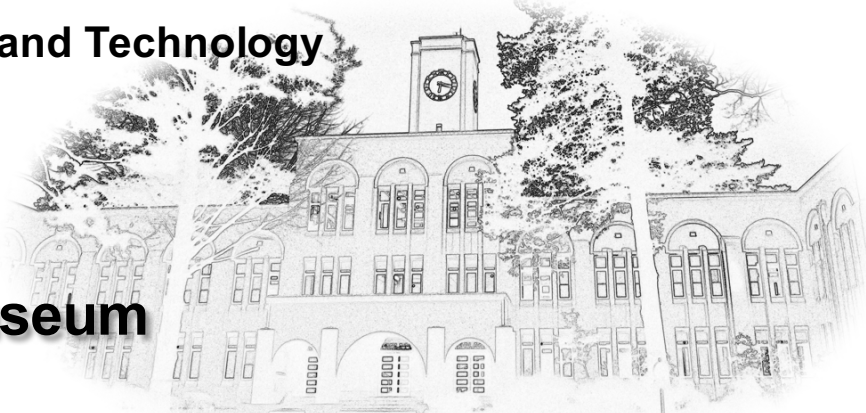

大学前」下車、農学部本館内



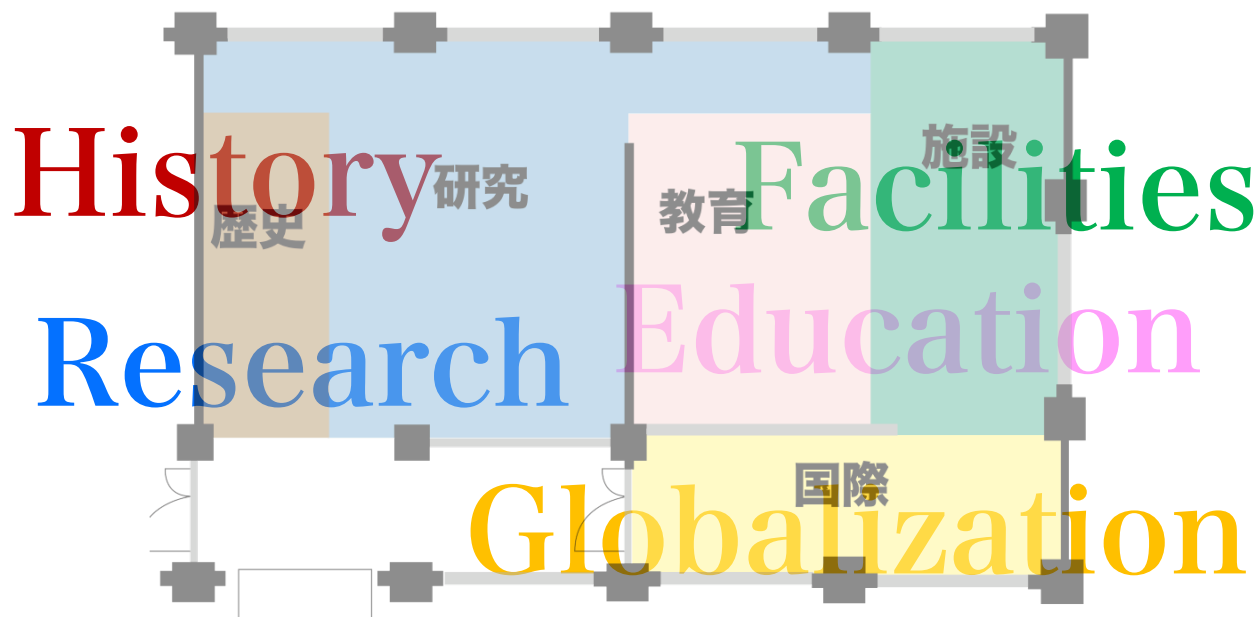

1874 Established as Agricultural Training Institute at Naito Shinjuku (currently known as Shinjuku Gyoen Park)  
 1935 Transferred to the current Fuchu location as Tokyo Imperial College of Agriculture and Forestry  
 1949 Established as Faculty of Agriculture, Tokyo University of Agriculture and Technology
